Footnotes

NAJCAT hopped a bit at the start, was quickly righted, then shifted immediately to the rail to gain a position inside a rival in the second flight racing into the backstretch, advanced inside foes to challenge for command when presented an opening nearing the quarter mile marker, gained a clear advantage along the inside approaching the furlong marker and just held FRENCH CHICK to the end under firm encouragement. The latter tracked off the second flight between foes under light rating in the opening half, angled to the rail approaching the far turn and continued with a steady advance along the rail racing into the stretch to bid inside the winner nearing the wire while proving only second best. MISS LIVINGSTON took up a position tracking the leaders in the second flight a bit off the inside racing into the backstretch, continued with a steady bid while shifting out four deep nearing upper stretch to challenge for command but couldn't match the top pair while finishing evenly in the last furlong. SPIRIT OF A NATION, bumped at the start, settled outside foes racing to the backstretch, was urged to advance while shifting out five wide racing through the far turn, continued in that path to upper stretch while finishing willingly to gain position to the end. SILVER ENCORE settled in last racing to the backstretch, shifted out splitting foes racing through the far turn, angled six wide racing into upper stretch and made some belated progress. CELTIC LASSIE sped to the fore in the opening stages, dictated the pace a bit off the rail into the backstretch, dueled for command racing through the far turn, shifted well off the inside entering upper stretch and gave way once headed by the winner. PASSION DIRECTED, reserved in hand while guided to the rail early to track off the second flight into the backstretch, shifted out racing through the far turn

while being prompted to advance but had no closing response. GIVENCHI broke a step slowly bumping SPIRIT OF A NATION, was settled four wide racing to the backstretch and lacked a rally. EMILY OSTROSKI, pulling while a bit rank between foes racing into the first turn, never gained contention. SARAH'S SPLENDOR shifted out early while being urged to terms with a rival on the lead, prompted the pacesetter racing into the far turn and gave way entering upper stretch. JOEY'S SUPRISE tracked off the second flight outside a rival in the opening half and gave way between foes racing through the far turn. CRAFTY VICKI flashed brief pace three deep racing to the backstretch and emptied out after five furlongs.
