Footnotes

SONGFOYA broke sharply to gain a clear advantage in the opening stages, dictated the pace on a comfortable margin along the inside racing into the turn and maintained that advantage throughout under some right handed pressure. SCHILLERTHEKILLER gained a position inside foes in the second flight, continued with a steady bid along the rail racing through the turn to upper stretch to gain second but couldn't gain terms with the winner. ENEMY FIRE tracked off the second flight between foes in the opening stages, shifted to the rail on the turn, saved ground into the stretch and continued with an effort to improve position inside foes while prevailing for a share. MILWAUKEE WOLF tracked the pace behind the second flight along the rail in the opening quarter, shifted out four wide racing into upper stretch and finished evenly in late stages. GREAT BAM tracked the leader four deep in the second flight in early stages, shifted in nearing the turn while being prompted to lodge a brief bid, couldn't gain terms with the winner and flattened out in upper stretch. TRUEBILL, reserved three deep between foes in the last flight early, shifted to the inside on the turn and continued with a steady effort to improve position. RICH CITY DUDE tracked off the second flight between foes in the opening stages, was fanned five wide racing into upper stretch and steadily faded. BEWARE THE TIGER threw his head then was bumped at the start, shifted in to track between foes in the last flight racing into the turn but offered no rally. ONE FOR BISCUIT was a brief factor between foes tracking just off the second flight, steadied out of tight quarters racing into the turn and quickly faded.

WILDWOOD HEIR broke inwards bumping BEWARE THE TIGER, was righted to track off the second flight racing five wide to the turn and dropped out early. SHEDROW HERO was a brief factor between foes in the second flight but steadily retreated nearing the midway point of the turn.
