WHISPERING BREEZE was urged to join the pace between foes racing into the first turn, continued to force the issue outside a rival into the backstretch, dueled for command with that one into upper stretch, gained a narrow advantage leaving the furlong marker and just held SILVER ROCK STAR to the end in a long drive. The latter, pulling a bit while taking up a position off the second flight a bit off the inside racing to the backstretch, steadily advanced to contention three deep racing into the far turn, continued in that path while gaining striking distance leaving the furlong marker and finished willingly to close the gap to the end. DUKE OF RUTHERFORD, urged to terms with several rivals on the pace along the rail racing into the first turn, attended the eventual winner's pace for a half, moved to press the issue inside that foe racing into the far turn, continued in a prolonged skirmish into upper stretch and was just outkicked. COOL PREN, in touch with the first flight three deep between foes in the opening stages, eased off the leaders to track those foes as part of the second flight a bit off the inside racing to the far turn, shifted out in the lane while being urged to challenge but had no final response. A NICE SLEWISH BOY tracked off the second flight along the inside into the backstretch, shifted out five wide racing into the stretch and continued evenly to late stages. MING GLO allowed to settled along the inside racing to the first turn, saved ground throughout and passed inside tiring rivals racing into the stretch. JACOB'S LIGHTHOUSE, bumped by RAJABLOU at the start, settled between foes three wide in the last flight racing to the backstretch and never gained

contention. OKLAHOMA HERO dwelt at the start to lose position to the field and never menaced thereafter. BINGORUN, caught four wide while being prompted to secure a forward placing racing into the first turn, steadily retreated after a half. STRONG LUCK, caught five wide racing into the first turn while tracking just off the first flight, dropped out early. RAJABLOU broke inwards bumping a rival, was urged to contend in the second flight along the inside racing into the backstretch but emptied out early.
