ROAD TO WAR moved to the fore from the break to dictate the pace a bit off the inside racing into the backstretch, continued to dictate terms on his own courage through the backstretch, forged clear racing into upper stretch and widened his margin under hand urging and some right handed prompting. JUMP TO START broke outwards bumping GRACIAS DERENZO, was held up just off the second flight racing into the backstretch, continued with a steady effort to split foes three deep racing into the far turn while being urged to challenge the leader, couldn't match that foe but continued under pressure to edge a rival for place honors nearing the wire. DAKOTA MILKSHAKE, forwardly placed along the inside tracking the pacesetter as part of the second flight in the opening stages, moved to challenge along the rail racing into the far turn, couldn't match terms with the winner nearing upper stretch and steadily faded late. COURTLY, held up out of close quarters in the opening stages, was guided to the rail to track off the second flight racing to the backstretch, made steady progress inside foes to gain some position racing into the far turn, shifted out four wide in upper stretch and finished evenly late. MILITARY LEGEND settled

into stride three deep between foes tracking off the second flight racing to the backstretch, was urged to advance splitting rivals four wide racing into upper stretch to gain some position but lacked the needed final response. IKAROS, reserved well off the field along the rail racing into the first turn, saved ground throughout and made a belated effort to improve his position. KHUKURI, urged to gain a forward placing four wide racing into the first turn, tracked the leader in second flight racing into the far turn and steadily faded midway through the second bend. NEXT KITTEN tracked the pace three deep between foes off the second flight racing into the backstretch and never gained contention. GRACIAS DERENZO, bumped at the start, was urged to a contending position between foes in the second flight racing into the backstretch continued under pressure between foes and emptied out nearing upper stretch. FRANK'S TIME, caught four wide tracking off the second flight racing into the first turn, continued five deep through the backstretch and steadily retreated after a half. HYDRO POWER, held up between foes off the second flight in the opening stages, never gained contention. TEXAS HEDGE, caught wide throughout, never menaced.
