Footnotes

NO GOOD DEED secured a forward placing along the rail in the opening stages, attended a rival's pace, moved to wrest command after a half and went clear under steady encouragement. SMOAKBOX joined the pace three wide in the opening stages, pressed the issue racing into upper stretch, couldn't match terms with the winner but held a rival for the place. FLYING ACT swerved out at the start into the path of SUSIE LARK, was quickly righted to gain a tracking position in second flight along the rail, came through inside foes to gain striking distance in upper stretch but finished evenly in the last furlong while earning a share. TRIPLE OVERTIME tracked the leaders between foes in the second flight, angled out four deep racing into upper stretch but had no final bid. CAST A COLD EYE hopped at the start, was settled off the second flight racing to the turn, then split foes three deep in upper stretch while making an effort to improve position. ICHABODS REVENGE tracked outside foes in the second flight racing into the turn, was fanned four deep leaving the turn and steadily faded in upper stretch. RUN OR PASS, carried out by SUSIE LARK and forced to steady off that foe at the start, never gained contention. COLE B broke in the air, was urged to the lead between foes in the opening quarter, disputed the pace into upper stretch and emptied out. SUSIE LARK, forced out into a rival's path at the start, never menaced thereafter.
