Footnotes

HART OF A COWBOY was prompted to join the pace three deep in the opening furlong, pressed the pace in that path racing into upper stretch, and edged forward of CAJUN DIABLO in the closing stages under steady left handed encouragement. The latter sped to the lead inside foes, disputed the pace inside foes into upper stretch, resisted the winner past the furlong marker but came up second best. FEAR NOR FAVOR settled outside a rival in the opening quarter, angled out five wide entering upper stretch and produced his best stride late to close the gap and gain a share. STORM LAKE tracked just off the first flight while under some pressure in the opening stages, moved to challenge three deep after a half but lacked the needed final response. KING AJAX was urged to dispute the pace between foes racing into the bend but gave way early. TERRIFIC TIM shifted outside foes racing unhurried from out of striking distance early, raced four wide to upper stretch but offered no closing bid. LET'S GO MAMBO settled along the inside early and never gained contention.
