Footnotes

MISS FONTANA, bumped at the start by SHINY STAR, was quickly righted to advance to striking distance four wide racing into the bend, moved to challenge three deep after a half and was roused clear to hold ELIZABETH PARK safe under steady encouragement. The latter angled inwards gaining position three deep in second flight, bid between foes in that path racing into the bend, briefly awaited an opening after a half, shifted outside the winner to challenge and continued willingly through the stretch to close the gap. SHINY STAR broke outwards bumping the eventual winner, was held up out of close quarters just after the break, tracked the leaders outside a rival to the bend, angled out five wide entering upper stretch and continued with a mild bid to gain a share. FLYIN'FLIRT, forwardly placed along the rail, eased off the leaders nearing the turn to track those foes along the rail, shifted out four wide in upper stretch to challenge but had no final kick. PEARL RING joined the pace three deep in the opening stages, dueled for command between foes into the turn, couldn't match the winner in upper stretch and gave way. TRIX OF TRADE broke outwards crowding SHINY STAR at the break, settled inside a rival tracking the pace, shifted out in upper stretch but offered no rally. ANOTHER MAMBO, allowed to settle near the inside early, never gained contention. LIL SUSIE TOO, pulling between foes in the opening stages, dueled for command racing into the turn and gave way abruptly after a half.
