Footnotes

ZOOMIE ZOOMIE, reserved well off the field while shifting nearer to the inside racing to the backstretch, gradually gathered momentum while shifting outside foes racing through the far turn, swung five wide in upper stretch and produced a stout rally to wrest command in time under strong handling. PASSPOST TO PARIS shifted to the rail racing into the first turn tracking the leader inside a rival in the second flight, switched out in upper stretch while being roused to challenge, ducked a bit under pressure in late stages but continued well enough to prevail for place honors. ROYAL RENAISSANCE, urged to secure the lead along the inside racing into the first turn, held sway on a clear margin into upper stretch but failed to sustain her momentum through the final sixteenth. LINDSEYTOTHEMAX, urged to a forward placing three deep between foes racing into the first turn, tracked outside foes in the second flight, made some progress four deep between foes in upper stretch but lacked the needed final response while momentarily losing her path to PASSPORT TO PARIS in late stages. FANTASTIC MADAME broke slowly, settled along the inside racing to the backstretch, swung outside foes racing into upper stretch

and made some belated progress. BUST OUT, caught five deep while being urged to contention racing to the first turn, was settled off the second flight nearing the backstretch, continued four wide into the far turn but lacked the needed final response. ART OF DECEPTION tracked off the second flight along the inside racing to the far turn but never gained contention. GOSTOSA tracked off the second flight between foes in the opening half, made a brief bid between foes on the far turn but quickly came up empty. SILVER DIRECTION, urged to a forward placing between foes racing to the first turn, tracked the leader outside a rival in second flight through the backstretch, shifted to the inside entering the second bend and steadily faded from contention. TADAAWI was pulled up after a half, then was vanned off the course. FOLLOWING THE RACE THE TRAINER OF LINDSEYTOTHEMAX LODGED A CLAIM OF FOUL AGAINST THE RIDER OF PASSPORT TO PARIS, ALLEGING INTREFERENCE IN THE STRETCH BUT THAT CLAIM WAS DISALLOWED.
