Footnotes

BOOGIE MAN JOE tracked off the first flight between foes under light rating racing to the bend, shifted out on the turn while moving to contention, angled four wide racing into upper stretch while being urged to advance, drew on terms with the pacesetter in late stages and edged that foe in time under brisk handling. COMMANDO KAT, prominent four deep in the opening stages, angled in on the turn while moving to challenge, took over in upper stretch to gain a clear advantage but couldn't deny the winner while resisting that foe to the end. SANDIA CREST, settled out of close quarters near the rail in the opening stages, shifted off the inside nearing the bend, swung eight wide racing into upper stretch and was going well late to close the gap on the top pair. EVAN TEMPERED, in close attendance to the pace three deep between foes, tracked just off the leaders racing into the bend and continued evenly between foes through the stretch. J COOL, bumped at the soundly start, was fanned nine wide racing through the stretch but continued with interest to improve position. SECRETO'S GOLD, bumped by J COOL at the start while off a bit slowly, angled seven wide racing into upper stretch and continued to improve his position. FRISKAWAY joined the pace between foes in the opening stages, dueled for command to the bend and emptied out racing into upper stretch. CUZIN DAVE, close up along the rail in the opening stages, steadily faded nearing upper stretch. STORMY DUDE, urged to lead along the rail, dueled for

command into upper stretch and gave way. IMMIDENT STORM tracked outside foes in the second flight racing to the bend but offered no closing bid. ROYAL OUTLAW tracked off the second flight racing into the turn and lacked a rally. LAND SAKES was never a factor.
