Footnotes

GRAND COMPOSER, reserved along the inside from well out of striking distance in the opening half, made a steady advance inside foes on the far turn, shifted out in upper stretch and produced a steady late response to wrest command and draw well clear under pressure. BURGAN RULES attended a rival's pace racing to the backstretch, pressed the issue nearing the far turn, moved clear nearing upper stretch but failed to sustain his momentum while proving best of the others. ONE FOR BISCUIT shifted out three wide gaining a position in the second flight racing to the backstretch, then continued evenly in that path to late stages while prevailing for a share. SWEEPY BLUFF was settled outside foes racing well off the pace in the opening half, angled five wide racing into upper stretch and made an effort to improve position. MAGIC MAN tracked the leaders along the inside in the second flight racing to the far turn

and soon retreated from contention. CATHYS BREEZE was settled into stride off the inside well off the second flight in the opening stages but never gained contention. ENEMY FIRE, urged to the lead along the inside racing to the backstretch, dueled for command inside a rival racing into the far turn and gave way nearing midstretch. IKAROS settled in last and passed only tiring rivals. BIG SMOOTH was settled off the second flight early and never mounted a serious challenge. DAKOTA MILKSHAKE tracked the leaders between foes in second flight in the opening half but emptied out racing through the far turn. IMAGE OF GRANDEUR was never a factor. CLOUD CASTLE showed little.
