The purse of \$20,000 and all additional fees will be divided as follows: 60% to first, 20% to second, 10% to third, 5% to fourth, 3% to fifth and 2% to sixth. The field will be limited to ten (10) starters. If less than ten (10) horses start, the purse monies not distributed will revert to the winning owner. Weights: Three-Year-Olds, 124 lbs., Older, 126 lbs. Total earnings in 2011- 2012 will be used to determine starters. In the event 2011-2012 earnings are the same, life time earnings will be used. Starters to be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. Nominations closed January 13, 2012, with 19 nominations and 1 supplement. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee. Trophy to the winner owner. (Supplementary nominations may be made at the time of entry for \$500 which will include all fees).
