PAVED IN GOLD rushed up to gain a clear early advantage, extended her lead on the turn, opened a comfortable lead under right hand urging in midstretch then was taken in hand while well clear in the final fifty yards. SUPERDUPER MISS checked at the start, rallied four wide while checking slightly on the turn and finished willingly to best the others. WIND TUNNEL raced along the inside for a half and improved her position with a mild rally. SEARCH FOR SALLY settled just off the early pace, lodged a mild bid from outside on the turn then tired in the drive. MAMA ELLA checked at the start and failed to threaten while saving ground. FORTUESQUE never reached contention. PAPANRIKA was never a factor while five wide. I'M A STINKER failed to mount a serious rally. MAGICAL GAL chased the winner along the rail to the turn and steadily tired thereafter. APETERBI never reached contention. FANTASY LAKE gave way on the turn.
