GOLDEN MISSILE stalked the pace outside EARLY WARNING, took over command inside the eighth pole and was under a vigorous hand ride to prevail. EARLY WARNING set the pace while three wide, steadied inside GOLDEN MISSILE just inside the sixteenth pole and continued on gamely to the wire. SIR BEAR rated off the pace, raced five wide on the turn, advanced to loom a threat in midstretch, then weakened. DELAY OF GAME chased the pace and tired. WICAPI lacked a rally. JUST RULER showed little. BLACK FOREST chased the pace, saved ground around the far turn and stopped.
