TIME FOR A CURE was rated close up to the pace, angled out entering the stretch, started her bid picking up a duel with ALL SPADES through the lane and was edging ahead nearing the wire. ALL SPADES raced off the pace on the outside, made her bid while widest on the final turn, had late aim then was outfinished. TIMA (ARG) ran close outside the early leaders, moved to position in the turn, dueled through the stretch and was outfinished nearing the wire. JULIES LOVE LETTER bobbled at the break, saved ground on the far turn, got fully motivated from midstretch, closed the gap then finished evenly. I NO BEST was rated clear, challenged from the quarter pole, dueled onto late stretch then weakened under pressure. SNOOPY'S LAST was steadied on the hedge into the first turn, raced just off the pace throughout then was empty in the stretch. SARAI'S DANCER raced just off the early pace then showed no response in the stretch. ASKARA raced off the pace and had no rally. T. N. T. RED stalked the pace, lacked room on the far turn then weakened in the stretch. GITANITA was well back early on, behind horses through the far turn, came off the hedge in the upper stretch, closed the gap then leveled off late. SKAYA raced off the pace then showed no response in the stretch.
