EUROPEAN ROSE set the pace along the inside, ducked in and was steadied approaching the eighth pole, then was all out to prevail. GRAND VERANDA stalked the pace outside EUROPEAN ROSE and continued on gamely for the place. BEAUTY SWEEP well placed while saving ground, steadied in behind EUROPEAN ROSE approaching the eighth pole, then continued on with good courage while in tight along the hedge. MYSTERY PLACE settled off the pace while three wide and lacked the needed late response. PEER REVIEW, off slowly, swung out for the stretch run and passed tired rivals. PLENTY SWEET chased the pace and tired. LADY BUCKINGHAM failed to menace after being outrun early. MI MI MINE showed little. SWEET RUNNER dwelt at the start and was not a threat. PAPANIKA was no factor. SEJM'S LUNAR STAR faded while racing four wide.
