Footnotes

GLITTERING STAR showed no early speed, advanced nearing the turn, was steadied lacking room at the quarter pole, got through entering the upper stretch then drew clear from midstretch. VECTOR stalked the pace, moved to a short brief lead on the turn, dueled between horses in the upper stretch then was clearly second best. GREAT PERFORMER raced just off the pace, advanced five wide through the turn then ran evenly through the stretch. GRANDÉE (VEN) stalked the pace, took a short lead nearing the quarter pole, dueled onto the eighth pole then weakened. COUNT ON KRIS raced outside and was no factor. POSITIVE JOHN stalked the pace, angled in entering the stretch then angled out in midstretch, flattening stride. DELTA LAUNCHING never competed and was distanced. JACQUE'S WILD WON took an early lead, was overcome in mid turn then eased through the stretch.
