Footnotes

THUNDER BLITZ jostled between rivals at the start, was taken back and angled in racing into the first turn, advanced into contention racing down the backstretch while racing off the rail, moved to take over inside TOUR OF THE CAT approaching the quarter pole and drew away under urging. TOUR OF THE CAT quickly moved up to make the pace racing three wide, responded when challenged by THUNDER BLITZ on the far turn, then couldn't stay with that rival in the drive while clearly second best. TALK IS MONEY chased the pacesetter four wide into the stretch and gave way. RADICAL RILEY bumped with THUNDER BLITZ at the start, chased the pace, raced three wide on the far turn and tired. OUTOFTHEBOX up close early while racing four wide, dropped back racing into the far turn, then had no response when set down for the drive. PAPA M AND M outrun early, rallied along the rail to reach contention on the far turn, then faltered. FREE OF LOVE raced five wide and was through after a half mile. WILD SUMMER bobbled at the start, then steadied to avoid running up on rivals on the first turn and was outrun. PROUD MAN bumped with THUNDER BLITZ at the start and was never a factor.
