PROSPECTRESS reserved after breaking slowly, angled out after entering the stretch and rallied to draw clear under urging. NOKIA allowed to settle early, rallied three wide on the far turn, took over command in early stretch but was no match for the winner in the final eighth. CARNELEVARE outrun early, improved her position without threatening the top two. FOREST GIPSY (BRZ) well placed into the stretch, lacked a late response. GROUCHO'S SIS chased the pace and tired. SHREW BE DO failed to menace. BEAUTIFUL ACTRESS, off slowly, swung wide for the stretch run and failed to threaten. MARQUISE MISS set the pace along the inside and faltered. LA MADELON (ARG) was outrun after breaking poorly. AZELNA (FR) prompted the pace and faded.
