**Footnotes**

LEAGLEYESER rated off the pace, came between rivals on the far turn, rallied inside QUEST DANCER to take over in early stretch and was fully extended to prevail. HERECOMETHEGIRLS chased the pace three wide, advanced into the attending position in the stretch but couldn't gain late. CLOCKWORK ORANGE (AUS) unhurried while saving ground, steadied along the inside on the far turn, recovered and closed along the inside to be up for the show. YOUR SONG allowed to settle, steadied in traffic on the far turn, then passed tired rivals between horses. QUEST DANCER sprinted to a clear lead along the inside, came off the rail entering the stretch and gave way. D J K STORM saved ground and lacked a late response. GERARDA'S TUNE chased the pace to nearing the stretch and tired. GITANITA raced in striking position into the far turn and faltered. SLIM PIC steadied when caught in tight early and was not a factor. CRYSTAL GATE was outrun while racing three wide. SEE U AT MY WINDOW chased the pace three wide into the far turn and faded.
