Footnotes

LUCK WE MET chased the pace, angled four wide on the turn, rallied to catch DR. SIX PENS at the sixteenth pole while lugging in, then drew clear while continuing to lug in to the wire. DR. SIX PENS vied for the lead racing off the rail, edged away in the stretch but couldn't match strides with the winner late. POSITIVE JOHN allowed to settle, outfinished the others for the show. PEQUOD off slowly, moved up quickly to vie for the lead three wide around the turn, then tired in the drive. COUNT ON KRIS failed to menace. GATE OPENER well placed into the turn, faltered. ONE BELL steadied when caught in tight at the start and was never a factor. MONTREAL'S SECRET chased the pace four wide into the turn and faded. SUPER ORINOCO was outrun. PIDGEON COLADA showed little.
