NOKIA rated off the pace after drifting out entering the first turn, rallied through the drive and wore down PAY THE GREEN late to prevail. The latter, set the pace along the rail, drew clear in midstretch but couldn't resist the winner while holding the place. PEACE N QUIET stalked the pace into the stretch and weakened. SHES JUST COOL, unhurried early, had a mild closing response in the drive. LADY DEVILLE chased the pace along the inside and tired. CALL ME DANCER was no factor after being carried out on the first turn. DUSTY'S LADY was through early. PINEY, carried out on the first turn, was outrun.
