EXCESSIVE PASSION chased outside, came out four wide into the stretch, rallied under urging to the lead outside foes in deep stretch and gamely prevailed. LOCKSLEY HALL sped to the early lead, angled in and set the pace along the inside and held on well but was caught late. SMILING TIGER pulled his way along to stalk the pace inside, came out a bit leaving the turn and into the stretch and finished gamely between horses late. BIG MAN HAS A SIGN wide early, chased outside then angled in leaving the backstretch, saved ground on the turn, continued inside in the stretch and was outfished. FACE AND AN ACE stalked between horses then outside a rival on the turn, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. DIXIE TROUPER settled outside then off the rail on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and could not summon the necessary late response. MAJESTIC AFLEET unhurried off the rail early, angled in a bit off the fence for the turn and lacked the needed rally. WILLYCONKER (IRE) a bit slow to begin, settled inside then a bit off the rail, went outside a rival leaving the turn and did not rally. HOLLYWOOD HARBOR stalked three deep, dropped back on the turn, was between foes leaving the turn and weakened. OUR MINESWEEPER allowed to settle inside then a bit off the rail on the turn, came out in the stretch and failed to menace.
