REAL ROCKPORT was reserved in the run down the backstretch, moved up between horses on the second turn, was asked for her best at the top of the lane, took the lead in midstretch, kicked clear and held to the wire. ZEES CHRIS chased a bit off the rail down the backstretch, moved up on the inside around the second turn, swung out for the drive and was gaining on the winner in the final yards. MEAN SARA JEAN settled at the back of the pack down the backstretch and around the turn, swung out for the stretch drive and rallied to gain the show in the final strides. KATELYN N' JENNA pulled her way to the lead into the first turn, held the advantage to the lane, relinquished command in midstretch and weakened on the inside in the final furlong. WARREN'S HOPEFUL found a comfortable stalking position around the first turn, moved up three deep with a bid down the backstretch, remained outside a rival on the second turn and fell back through the stretch drive. TRUE BEAUTY angled over to press the pace around the first turn and down the backstretch, began to weaken at the five sixteenths pole and fell back through the stretch.
