### Footnotes

THE DEMPSEY LOOK chased between horses on the backstretch and turn, came three deep into the stretch and rallied under left handed urging to get up late. UGOTADOWHATUGOTADO between horses early, dueled outside a rival, put a head in front on the turn, inched clear in the stretch but was caught late. OUR FLING (NZ) between horses early, dropped back a bit off the rail, came out in midstretch and found her best stride late. SHEBEEN (GB) stalked off the rail then outside a rival, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. ACLEVERSHADEOFJADE off a bit slowly, chased inside, steadied in tight off heels into the stretch, got through along the rail in the lane and could not quite offer the necessary late kick. QUATRIN stalked the pace off the rail then angled in leaving the backstretch, came out into the stretch, was in a bit close between foes past midstretch and lacked the needed response. MOYANNA (IRE) chased four wide on the backstretch and three deep on the turn and did not rally. WILSHE AMAZE went up inside to duel for the lead to the stretch, was between foes past midstretch and weakened. LADY WILDCAT was in a good position chasing between horses on the backstretch and three deep on the turn and also weakened. THUNDER'S ECHO dwelt at the start to be off well behind the field, saved ground and was outrun. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the start but made no change when they ruled THUNDER'S ECHO was the cause of her own trouble.
