AMERICAN STORY sped to the early lead, set a pressured pace inside, inched away in upper stretch and proved best under some urging. CRISIS OF SPIRIT between foes early, prompted the pace outside the winner to the stretch and was clearly second best. MAKOMA saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch and picked up the show. LEA THE PUNISHER three deep into the first turn, stalked off the rail then outside a rival, came three wide into the stretch and weakened. GUMPTION chased outside a rival then three deep leaving the backstretch and into the second turn, dropped back off the rail, drifted out some into the stretch and gave way.
