Footnotes

PICKLE (GB) chased outside then alongside a rival, swung four wide into the stretch, rallied to the front outside foes past the eighth pole and held on gamely under urging. MAKEUP ARTIST chased inside, came a bit off the rail on the second turn, split horses past midstretch, and closed gamely inside the winner. AMORAMA (FR) allowed to settle outside a rival, angled in on the second turn, came out into the stretch and again in upper stretch and finished well for the show. MEA DOMINA pulled her way between horses and was in a bit tight into the first turn, stalked outside a rival, bid three deep on the second turn and into the stretch, gained the advantage nearing midstretch but weakened some in the final furlong. BELLE ANGE (FR) stalked the pace inside, bid along the rail and bumped with the pacesetter in midstretch but could not offer the necessary response in the final furlong. ANTEDILUVIAN (GB) off a bit slowly, settled just off the rail then outside a rival on the backstretch and second turn, came out into the stretch and did not rally. FESTIVAL (JPN) had good early speed inside then stalked the pace along the rail, bid between foes into and on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. FIVE NICKELS went up three deep to gain the lead on the first turn, angled in and set the pace inside, dueled along the rail on the second turn and into the stretch, was bumped when between foes in midstretch and weakened.
