Footnotes

NIMA'S PAD pulled his way up inside to stalk the pace, bid along the rail on the second turn, took a short lead leaving that turn and gamely prevailed under some urging and a strong hand ride. KIELBASA sped to the early lead, angled in and set a pressured pace inside, dueled between rivals on the second turn, fought back outside the winner in the stretch and went willingly to the wire. MUSCLE 'N MANE prompted the pace outside the runner-up then three deep on the second turn and weakened but bested the others. EL FALCON settled a bit off the rail then outside a rival to the stretch and did not rally. CARONA TIME between foes early, chased a bit off the rail then inside on the second turn and weakened. OLD THAMESIAN a bit slow to begin, saved ground off the pace, came out a bit in the stretch and was not a threat. ARMY OFFICER five wide into the first turn, tracked the pace outside then bid three deep on the backstretch, stalked again on the second turn, came out into the stretch and had little left. BUDDYANDROWDY four wide into the first turn, settled off the rail, went three deep on the second turn and into the stretch and lacked a further response.
