SUMMER MOVIE pulled his way along to stalk the pace outside, bid three deep on the backstretch, gained the lead nearing the second turn, inched away and angled in, fought off a pair of bids again leaving that turn to clear again into the stretch and proved best under urging. HOCKLEY saved ground chasing the pace, moved up inside on the second turn and into the stretch and held second. THOMAS BAINES chased three deep between foes on the first turn then a bit off the rail, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch and just missed the place. GILLIGAN tried to rear, pushed open the gate a moment early and hopped to be away slowly, angled in and saved ground off the pace, cut the corner into the stretch and improved position inside. COLOURSOFTHEGLEN (IRE) pulled his way along to duel outside a rival, took the lead and angled in on the backstretch, battled inside, bid again between foes leaving the second turn and weakened in the stretch. SIETE MACHOS pulled on the early lead and dueled inside, came out on the backstretch and bid between horses, bid again three deep leaving the second turn and also weakened in the drive. KEEN BIDDER (GB) four wide into the first turn, chased three deep on the backstretch and second turn and did not rally. THEATRICAL PRO chased between horses to the stretch and lacked a further response. The stewards conducted an inquiry into the start but made no change when they ruled GILLIGAN caused his own trouble and did not gain an unfair advantage at the break.
