Footnotes

GOING FOR A SPIN saved ground chasing the pace, moved up inside into and on the turn, bid along the rail in the stretch, gained the lead past midstretch and won clear under steady handling. ZENIDEKKA sped to the early lead, inched away on the backstretch, set the pace inside, came a bit off the rail into the stretch, battled outside the winner in the drive, could not match that one in the final sixteenth but was clearly second best. QUEENIE MARINI stalked the pace outside then off the rail, went three deep on the turn and into the stretch and held third. SUBPOENA THE DRESS a bit slow to begin, settled off the rail then outside, came three wide into the stretch and was edged for the show. MELBISHA four wide early, chased off the rail, angled in some for the turn, came out in the stretch and lacked a rally. CARRIE ROSE between horses early, stalked off the rail, split rivals on the turn and weakened in the stretch.
