Footnotes

LAGUNA MISS, went up between horses to vie for command on the backstretch, took the lead and inched clear on the second turn, then drew off under a steady hand ride. DESERT DRY SACK settled off the rail, angled in leaving the backstretch and picked up the place inside. BETRAYER, hustled along early, moved up menacingly four wide on the second turn, then just held third. BONNET'S BOUNTY, crowded at the start, steadied into the first turn, went up four wide on the second turn and five wide into the stretch but could not sustain her bid. PRIZED POLICY, between rivals early, split foes nearing the stretch but lacked the needed rally. MID LIFE CRISIS, came off the rail on the backstretch, went four wide into the stretch and failed to menace. SLICED TOMATOES, sped to the early lead inside, dueled inside on the backstretch but began to weaken on the second turn. BOOTS MCGOLD, went up three deep with a bid on the backstretch, dropped back on the second turn and gave way. KINGS DELIGHT trailed off the rail throughout and was outrun. DETERMINELLA, fractious in the gate, broke a bit in the air and slowly, raced four wide, dropped back into the second turn, was pulled up and was vanned off.
