(Winners that have started for a claiming price of \$25,000 or less in their last 3 starts and maidens that are non-starters for a claiming price have second preference). All fees will be refunded to horses which fail to draw into this race.

Footnotes

THROW ME A CURVE saved ground chasing the pace, moved up between horses in traffic on the turn, swung five wide into the stretch and rallied under urging to get up late. BILO had good early speed between foes then dueled outside a rival, inched away in midstretch, continued toward the inside and was caught late. FAIRLY CRAFTY off a bit slowly, moved up just off the inside, went between horses on the turn, split rivals in midstretch and gained the show. AT A BOY LUTHER had speed between foes then stalked the dueling leaders, bid three wide on the turn and into the stretch, was between horses in midstretch and lacked the needed late kick. RECKLESS HERO bumped at the start, chased outside, went five wide into and on the turn and into the stretch and lacked the necessary final response. GO WILD chased off the rail on the backstretch and turn, came four wide into the stretch and was not a threat.

SUMMER SPORT chased between horses on the backstretch and into the turn, angled in leaving the bend and could not summon the necessary rally. STAND BY YOUR FLAG steadied in tight early, saved ground off the pace, came out leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch and improved position. STEEL CUTLASS sent inside to duel for the lead, fought back along the rail on the turn and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. ZOOLU NIGHTS bumped at the start, settled off the rail, came wide into the stretch and failed to menace. KING GEORGE W. between horses early, stalked the pace inside or a bit off the rail to the stretch and weakened. ORO DESERT close up stalking the pace five wide on the backstretch and four wide on the turn, came out into the stretch and weakened. MCMANUS had the rider lose the whip early on the backstretch, stalked four wide between horses, continued three deep leaving the turn and had little left for the stretch.
