Footnotes

WENDY'S ON TO ME unhurried off the rail early, steadied briefly off heels past the quarter pole, swung out four wide into the stretch and rallied under left handed urging to get up late. DEL MAR MISS wide early, stalked outside then three deep on the turn and into the stretch, gained a slim lead in midstretch, bumped with a rival late and continued gamely between foes at the wire. VALID'S VALID stalked between horses, continued off the rail into the stretch, had the rider lose the whip in midstretch and surged between foes late. KOHAR moved up between horses to duel for the lead, battled outside a rival into and on the turn and between horses through the drive, bumped with the runner-up late but continued willingly. FEEL THE HEAT unhurried off the rail early, angled to the inside for the turn, came out leaving the bend, was in tight off heels nearing the stretch, swung three deep into the lane and improved position.'. QUICK COVER sped to the early lead and angled in, dueled inside, fought back on the turn and in the stretch but weakened late. I CAN YODELE stalked the pace a bit off the rail then along the inside, dropped back into the stretch and weakened. BUFFY MY LOVE saved ground chasing the pace, went around a rival into the stretch, then drifted in and did not rally. LILA HOPE stalked between horses then outside, was in a bit tight leaving the backstretch,

went three deep on the turn and weakened. SILENT KINGDOM chased the pace between horses, swung five wide into the stretch and lacked a further response. MECH RUNNER in a bit tight early, settled inside then a bit off the rail, came out on the turn and five wide into the stretch and was not a threat. BELLA MAGIC bobbed at the start, dropped back between horses, settled off the rail and was outrun. A claim of foul by the rider of KOHAR against the runner-up was not allowed by the stewards, who ruled both runners contributed to the contact between them.
