Weight 124 lbs. Non-winners of \$60,000 at a mile or over in 2005 allowed 3 lbs. Such a race at any time allowed 5 lbs. Such a race at any distance on 2004-05 allowed 7 lbs. Non-winners of a race at a mile or over other than maiden, claiming or starter allowed 10 lbs. Trophies will be presented to the winning owner and trainer. (S)

Footnotes

ROBADOR saved ground off the pace, came out on the second turn and four wide into the stretch, lugged inward in midstretch then rallied under left handed urging to get up late. LUCKY J. H. chased off the rail, moved up four wide on the second turn, bid three deep into the stretch, lugged in and bumped a rival while taking the lead in midstretch, inched away in deep stretch but was caught late. TOP THIS AND THAT settled outside a rival then a bit off the rail, moved up inside into the stretch, came out in deep stretch and gained the show late. THOR'S ECHO had good early speed and dueled outside a rival then between horses, continued inside leaving the second turn, was bumped in midstretch and weakened late. TEXCESS pulled his way along four wide into the first turn, stalked outside then bid three deep on the backstretch and second turn, continued between horses into the stretch, was bumped between foes in midstretch and also weakened late. KING MOBAY chased outside, came three deep into the stretch, steadied off heels in deep stretch and lacked the needed late kick. PANAMA LANE chased off the rail then angled in on the first turn and saved ground, came out into the stretch and could not offer the necessary late response. PROUD TOWER TOO pulled his way along and steadied early, was in tight leaving the first turn, stalked a bit off the rail to the stretch and weakened. REGAL PAN off a bit slowly, angled in and saved ground off the pace and failed to menace. TOMMY'S TOPPER broke slowly, went up inside to duel for the lead, dropped back nearing the quarter pole and gave way. NEW CLOUD pulled his way along and steadied in tight early, raced

close up inside stalking the pace, dropped back on the backstretch and second turn, also gave way and was eased. SLEWSBAG off a bit slowly, angled in and saved ground off the pace, was always outrun, was eased in the stretch, unsaddled at the wire when broke down behind and vanned off.
