G. I. BETTY chased a bit off the rail or inside, came out for room into the stretch, gained the advantage under a brisk hand ride three deep past the sixteenth pole and proved best under a long hold late. FOREST MISS prompted the early pace inside then stalked along the rail, came out into the stretch, re-bid alongside the pacesetter, put a head in front past the eighth pole, could not match the winner but was clearly second best. MARVELOUS MARCIA stalked three deep then outside on the backstretch and second turn, came four wide into the stretch, drifted in but rallied late to edge a rival on the wire for third. KARLEE'S KITTEN had good early speed and dueled outside a rival then a bit off the rail, inched away and angled in on the second turn, fought back in the stretch, weakened some late but just lost the show. CHELCEE'S HOPE pulled between horses to stalk the early pace then bid outside a rival and dueled for the lead, stalked again on the second turn, came out into the stretch and weakened. CAJUN MONARCH saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and did not rally. BROAD TRY unhurried outside a rival then a bit off the rail leaving the backstretch, angled to the inside in the stretch and lacked a further response.
