CAMILLE C bobbled a bit at the start, had good early speed and angled in on the first turn, set the pace inside, responded when challenged on the second turn, inched away again in the stretch and won clear under an energetic hand ride and a late crack of the whip. SALTY FRIES stalked inside then a bit off the rail, found the fence again for the second turn, came out a bit in midstretch, drifted in late and was clearly second best. LA NEZ chased between horses then outside a rival, moved up three deep on the backstretch, bid alongside the winner on the second turn and weakened in the stretch but clearly bested the others. COSTANTA chased three deep then outside on the backstretch, continued three wide on the second turn and into the stretch and lacked a further response. TWISTNTHENIGHTAWAY chased a bit off the rail then inside, cut the corner into the stretch and did not rally. SHE'S NOT LION stalked the pace inside then between horses on the backstretch, continued outside a rival on the second turn and weakened in the stretch. BLIND OPTIMISM pulled her way along three deep then stalked outside a rival, was between foes into the second turn and again into the stretch and had little left for the drive.
