**Footnotes**

SQUEEZE ME TIGHT stalked off the rail then three deep on the turn and into the stretch and rallied under left handed urging to get up outside foes on the line. MIDNIGHT RAGE sped to the early lead, set the pace off the rail, drifted out some in the stretch and held on well but was caught between foes late. SILENT STALK close up tracking the leader off the inside, angled to the rail in the stretch and finished well to just miss. RIVER GLOW chased off the rail or outside, came out into the stretch and continued willingly. CARNIVAL QUEEN (GB) settled a bit off the rail then three deep into the turn, continued outside a rival into the stretch and was outfinished. YASINISI (IRE) chased between horses then outside a rival leaving the turn and could not summon the necessary late kick. ONEFUNSONOFAGUN was in a good position stalking the pace three deep to the stretch and lacked the needed rally. FOUNDATION ROOM (IRE) stalked the pace inside on the backstretch and turn and also lacked the necessary late response. PARTY WITH BRANDO hopped in a slow start, saved ground off the pace, came out in the stretch and was not a threat. BIRDIE BIRDIE between horses early, angled in and settled a bit off the rail, dropped back between foes into the turn and lacked a further response.
