**Footnotes**

ALPHIE'S BET broke a bit slowly, settled just off the rail, moved up under urging three deep on the second turn and into the stretch, gained the advantage in midstretch and won clear. WORKING CAPITAL had speed three wide then angled in and set the pace inside, kicked clear on the backstretch, fought back along the fence in midstretch, could not match the winner late but was second best. MR TOKYO stalked the pace inside, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch and held third. CAHILL COUNTRY stalked a bit off the rail then outside into the second turn, continued off the inside into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. SELF MADE came off the rail on the first turn, chased outside a rival on the backstretch, angled three deep into the stretch and could not summon the necessary response. STRAIGHTMIDNIGHT four wide early, chased three deep then outside, came three wide into the stretch and weakened. WARREN'S KONG settled outside a rival then a bit off the rail, found the inside on the second turn and did not rally. LEAVING NEW YORK three deep early, prompted the pace outside the runner-up then stalked off the rail, dropped back between foes on the second turn and gave way.
