Footnotes

SPRING STAR (FR) reluctant to load, pulled her way along and angled in outside a rival early, stalked off the rail, bid outside the pacesetter into the stretch and gained a short lead, then drew clear under some urging and good handling. QUERO QUERO chased between horses or outside a rival, swung four wide into the stretch, came in a bit in deep stretch but closed gamely for the place. DUBLINO saved ground stalking the pace, went between horses on the second turn, drifted out some past midstretch, then split foes late and just missed second. DIMITROVA stalked the pace outside a rival then a bit off the rail on the second turn, came out some in the stretch, was between foes in deep stretch and lacked the needed late kick. KATDOGAWN (GB) chased outside or off the rail, launched a bid four wide on the second turn and into the stretch, steadied when crowded in deep stretch and could not offer the necessary response. MAKEUP ARTIST hesitated in a bit of a slow start, saved ground off the pace, came out into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. FUDGE FATALE sped to the early lead and angled in, set the pace inside, battled inside the winner into the stretch and to midstretch, then weakened. FUN HOUSE saved ground stalking the pace to the stretch and also weakened. ESMAY (AUS) was in a good position stalking the pace three deep then between foes on the second turn, dropped back into the stretch and had little left.
