### Footnotes

MERRYTAGIO chased outside a rival, angled to the inside leaving the turn, came out in midstretch and rallied under left handed urging to wear down the runner-up approaching the wire. D SUGARBARS stalked the pace inside, bid along the rail on the turn to gain the lead nearing the stretch, kicked clear but could not hold off the winner. HAUNTED HIGHWAY chased outside rivals on the backstretch and turn, came three deep into the stretch and picked up the show. SCENT OF CHRISM broke a bit slowly, settled off the rail then outside a rival, came out into the stretch and improved position. MS TREASURE HUNTER stalked off the rail, bid outside a rival on the turn and three deep a quarter mile out and weakened in the stretch. TOUCH LUCK settled inside then a bit off the rail on the turn and into the stretch and did not rally. MISS MANHATTAN stalked between horses on the backstretch and turn, came three deep into the stretch and weakened. STREET RUN settled outside a rival chasing the pace, swung out into the stretch and failed to menace. WARREN'S MISS SEXY sped to the early lead and angled in, set the pace a bit off the rail, dueled inside a rival on the turn and between horses leaving the turn and had little left for the stretch.
