JOEY FRANCO stalked outside a rival then a bit off the rail, went between horses on the turn, bid three deep into the stretch, gained a short lead in deep stretch and proved best under urging. BONUS PAY DAY had good early speed and dueled between horses, inched away on the turn, fought back inside the winner in the stretch and just held second. COMMANDER'S FLAG unhurried off the rail on the backstretch, moved up some just off the fence on the turn, swung out into the stretch and just missed the place. WAINGARTH saved ground chasing the pace, came out on the turn, angled inward in the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. RIDE AND SHINE settled off the rail, went outside on the turn and five wide into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. SWORDFISH came off the rail on the backstretch, chased four wide on the turn and into the stretch and did not rally. GREY MEMO broke alertly then dropped back well off the rail, lagged back, came four wide into the stretch and was not a threat. SOMBRIO pulled early, angled in and dueled inside, stalked along the rail on the turn and weakened. GENERAL CHALLENGE had good early speed and dueled three deep, dropped back on the turn, drifted wide into the stretch, gave way, drifted inward through the drive and was eased.
