CAPE TRUTH angled in and dueled inside, inched away a bit off the rail in the stretch, drifted in then out some from the whip in the final furlong but held on gamely. QUINDICI MAN settled inside then a bit off the rail, swung out into the stretch and closed willingly late. LIFE GOES ON three deep on the first turn, stalked off the rail or outside a rival, went up three wide into and on the second turn and into the stretch and held third between horses late. DOVER STREET ART (IRE) chased between foes then a bit off the rail, angled in for the second turn, continued inside in the stretch, steadied when crowded off heels in midstretch and was edged for the show. LEAVENWORTH had good early speed and dueled outside the winner, fought back on the second turn, lugged in when between horses in midstretch and weakened some in the final furlong. BET ON VICTOR chased inside then a bit off the rail, came out leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally.
