Footnotes

CARIBBEAN CUTIE was close up inside early, bid inside LYNs KISSING STAR on the turn, took a short lead into the stretch and kicked clear under urging. LYNs KISSING STAR sped to the early lead a bit off the rail, dueled outside the winner on the turn and into the stretch, could not match that one in the final furlong and just held second. EMPTY PURSE, stalked outside the winner early, continued just behind the top pair on the turn and three deep into the stretch and went willingly to the wire. STOP SMOKING, flipped and fell when fractious during the warm up, broke a bit slowly, raced a bit off the rail, split rivals in upper stretch, came out and improved position. BLUE WEST had a rail trip and lacked the needed response. COLOMBIAN SNOW, bobbled at the start, was roused early, split rivals on the turn and failed to menace. TONGA TESS, broke a bit slowly, raced off the rail and was not a threat. HANG TOWN, also off a bit slowly and wide early, angled in for the turn and was not a factor. DADDYSLILKATIEGIRL, went three deep between foes on the turn and gave way. CORDAL BAY raced wide throughout and four wide on the turn and also gave way.
