Footnotes

BRONSTER stalked outside then alongside a rival, bid outside the pacesetter in the stretch to gain the lead, inched away and held under some urging. LANA'S SMILE chased a bit off the rail, split horses on the turn, came out into the stretch and finished well. THE GREAT CAPER bumped at the start, chased outside a rival then a bit off the rail, went around a foe in midstretch and continued willingly inside. GUTSHOT STRAIGHT chased outside, went three deep on the turn and four wide into the stretch and was outfinished. WALKIN D TALK broke in and bumped a rival, sped to the early lead, set the pace a bit off the rail, battled inside the winner in midstretch and weakened. GOTCHER NUMBER was in a good position stalking the pace inside, continued along the rail in the stretch and also weakened. JASON between horses early, chased inside to the stretch and did not rally. WARREN'S KING KONG steadied in tight along the inside early, came out into the turn and again into the stretch and was not a threat.
