Footnotes

SILVER HEAT stalked off the rail or between foes, moved up- between horses on the second turn, came out four wide into the stretch, bid alongside the pacesetter to gain the lead in midstretch, inched away under urging and just held. LAURA BEASLEY angled in and settled a bit off the rail then chased inside, came out into the stretch and again nearing midstretch and closed gamely. WARRENS MATCHMAKER stalked the pace inside, came out into the stretch and held third. WARRENS SWEETHONEY pulled her way to the early lead, drifted out a bit into the first turn then angled in and set the pace inside, fought back in midstretch and weakened some to be outfinished for a minor award. TIZ SMOKE TIZ FIRE chased inside then a bit off the rail, found the fence again on the second turn and in the stretch and lacked the needed late kick. SHADY MARKET angled in and settled outside a rival then three deep on the backstretch, came out leaving the second turn and three wide into the stretch and could not offer the necessary response. MULTIPLYINGTHEHEAT unhurried outside a rival early, came out leaving the second turn and into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. BITT A HEAT broke inward and slowly, settled off the pace inside, came out a bit into the stretch and was not a threat. ISN'T SHE SWEET fanned four wide into the first turn, stalked outside, came out four wide again into the stretch and weakened. MABEEAWISHCOMETRUE also four wide into the first turn, stalked outside rivals on the backstretch and second turn, also came four wide into the stretch and weakened. TRAIL BEYOND stalked the pace off the rail, was between horses leaving the second turn and weakened in the stretch. ITALIAN SPIRIT fanned five wide into the first turn, settled outside then off the rail, angled in on the second turn and was

not a factor.
