Footnotes

BILA SHAKA forced or stalked the pace outside then off the rail on the turn, came three deep into the stretch, gained the lead nearing midstretch and pulled clear under some urging. LUCKYVIC was sent up inside to duel for the lead, put a head in front on the turn, fought back in midstretch, could not match the winner in the final furlong but held second. FULL FASHIONED close up stalking the pace three deep, came four wide into the stretch and was edged for the

place. WARREN'S CITY ART settled off the rail then outside a rival into and on the turn and was outfinished for a minor award. WINTER BLOSSOM broke outward, raced well wide on the backstretch and off the rail on the turn, came four wide into the stretch and put in a late bid at a minor share. DUSTBOWL broke slowly, settled off the rail then angled in, saved ground on the turn, came out into the stretch and improved position. NO RULES TONIGHT between horses early, stalked inside on the backstretch and turn and weakened in the stretch. NEGRA TOMASA angled in and saved ground chasing the pace, continued along the rail in the stretch, was in a bit tight a sixteenth out and did not rally. NAPOTE stalked between horses on the backstretch and turn, fell back leaving the turn and weakened. KRASAVITSA had good early speed off the rail, dueled between horses then outside the runner-up on the turn, was between foes again into the stretch and also weakened. DRAMATIC REWARD unhurried off the rail early, angled in some on the turn, came out in the stretch and failed to menace, then was unsaddled at the mile pole and vanned off. SOCIETY'S ORPHEN broke slowly, moved up inside then outside a rival, dropped back and drifted out on the turn and gave way.
