SLOW DOWN unhurried a bit off the rail then outside a rival, split horses twice on the second turn, came three deep into the stretch and rallied gamely to prove best. SPEED OF THOUGHT settled inside, saved ground off the pace, waited a bit leaving the second turn then closed gamely between foes late for second. NO MALO saved ground stalking the pace, came out into the stretch, was between foes in midstretch and lost the place late. GRACE AVENUE stalked the leader off the rail, bid outside that one on the second turn, gained the lead in upper stretch, fought back past midstretch but weakened late. STAR'S MILLENNIUM saved ground in midpack to the stretch, came out in upper stretch and was outfinished. HOT SALT (FR) a bit crowded at the start, went three deep into the first turn, chased outside a rival, found the rail for the second turn and weakened. CANDACE IN ASPEN off a bit slowly, trailed while saving ground, went outside a rival on the second turn and lacked the needed rally. BREAKFASATBLUEBIRD sped to the early lead and angled in, set the pace along the inside, dueled inside a rival on the second turn and into the stretch and weakened in the final furlong. SHATTERED SILENCE chased three deep early then outside on the backstretch, came four wide into the stretch and also weakened.
