GREG'S GOLD went up inside to duel for the lead, put a head in front leaving the backstretch, inched away into the stretch and held on gamely under urging. HE'S THE RAGE stalked the pace outside a rival then off the rail, angled in for the turn, came out in upper stretch and continued willingly to the wire. BILO dueled outside a rival then three deep to the stretch, drifted inward through the drive and held third. AREYOUTALKINTOME chased inside then outside a rival on the turn, came out four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally. DESERT BOOM chased off the inside, angled to the rail on the turn and could not summon the necessary response. CIGAR PAL was taken off the rail and settled outside a rival on the backstretch and turn and did not rally. DEBONAIR JOE dropped back off the rail on the backstretch, angled to the inside on the turn and did not rally. SCOTTSBLUFF dueled off the rail then between foes, steadied when crowded in upper stretch and weakened.
