EL MARTILLO saved ground chasing the pace, came out into the stretch, angled back to the fence in midstretch, rallied along the rail under urging to gain the lead in deep stretch and gamely prevailed. DON TITO bobbled at the start but quickly recovered and stalked just off the rail, came out leaving the turn and three deep into the stretch, split horses four wide with a bid a sixteenth out and continued willingly to the wire. BET ON VICTOR angled in and dueled outside a rival, came out some in the stretch, fought back between horses a sixteenth out and was outfinished. INFORMED broke in a bit, dueled inside, came off the rail in the stretch, was between horses in deep stretch and weakened late. KELLY LEAK settled off the rail then chased outside the winner, came out leaving the turn and four wide into the stretch and lacked the needed rally.
