ROCK O was sent along four wide early, dueled outside BENSWAKI on the turn, drew clear and held sway under some urging and steady handling. MALIBU MOON, brushed the gate at the start, was sent between horses, continued outside DELIGHT OF SUMMER on the turn and closed the gap late. DELIGHT OF SUMMER was sent between horses into the turn, continued inside and picked up the show. BENSWAKI, dueled inside the winner into and on the turn and weakened. TRUE VICTORY, wide early and four wide into the turn, angled in a bit and did not rally. DE FROSTER was sent between foes early, lugged out and steadied early on the turn and continued wide. LOST IN PARADISE, off a bit slowly, dropped back, went outside ALL IN A DAYS WORK into the stretch and failed to menace. DINNERATHEPALMS off a bit slowly, raced outside and did not rally. FUTURE PROMISE sent between foes early, continued four wide on the turn and five wide into the stretch and weakened. ALL IN A DAYS WORK, broke alertly and was shuffled back along the rail leaving the backstretch, came out for the stretch and gave way.
