LA FEMINN prompted the pace outside the runner-up while in hand, took a short lead leaving the turn and kicked clear under some urging and steady handling. THERESA'S TIZZY sped to the early lead and angled in, set a pressured pace along the inside, fought back when headed, could not match the winner but was clearly second best. GOURMET GIRL raced close up four wide on the backstretch and into the turn, continued three deep on the bend and into the stretch and picked up the show. IMAGE OF GLORY chased the leaders between horses on the backstretch and outside a rival on the turn, came three deep into the stretch and lacked the needed response. BRIGHT MAGIC saved ground chasing the pace to the turn, came out on the bend and also lacked a rally. MEMORANDA wide early, angled in on the backstretch, raced outside a rival on the turn, angled in again into the stretch and did not rally. ALOHA MANGOS settled a bit off the inside, angled to the rail on the turn and did not rally. FASCINATE unhurried early, had a rail trip and was outrun.
